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1 ソフトウェアの説明

このソフトウェアは、PC でヒューマンマシンインタフェース(HMI)のユーザーアプリケーションを開発するための統合開発環境を提供します。開発した HMI ユーザーアプリケーションは、ランタイムソフトウェアによって複数のハードウェアで動作します。

ランタイムのインストールまたはアンインストールは、管理者権限で実行してください。

プロジェクトファイルを転送する場合、転送前にランタイムを管理者権限で起動してください。

4.2 不正アクセス防止のための安全なネットワークを構築する

- 暗号化された通信を使用した通信環境を構築してください。(例: VPN)
- イーサネット経由で通信を確立してデータを転送する前に、ネットワークの安全性を確認してください。
- イーサネット通信に基づいていない転送オプションを選択します。(例: USB ケーブルまたはファイルシステム)
イーサネット通信に基づいた転送オプションが必要な場合は、IPsec の使用を推奨します。
- 通信サービスを使用する場合にのみ、データ通信用のポートを開いてください。
- パソコンはファイアウォールで保護し、信頼できる安全なネットワークでご使用ください。
- 表示器は信頼できる安全なネットワークに設置し、ファイアウォールで保護してください。

4.3 表示器上での権限外操作を防止する

- セキュリティー機能を使用してください。
 - 自動ログアウト機能を使用してください。
 - ロックを解除するための適切なセキュリティレベルを、限定されたユーザーにのみ与えてください (管理者権限を持つユーザーのみにロック解除を許可する等)。

 - 接続機器オペレーションブロック - Upload (USB Storage/SD Card)
 - 接続機器オペレーションブロック - Download (USB Storage/SD Card)
 - ハードウェア設定画面の表示

上記のオペレーションで使用されるスイッチに、セキュリティレベルの設定をしてください。

- 表示器への接続に **Web Viewer** を使用している場合、パスワードを表示させる [***] ボタンは押さないでください。表示させたパスワードは、接続されているすべての表示器および **Web Viewer** クライアントに表示されます。

4.3.1 SP5000 シリーズオープンボックス (Windows 10 IoT Enterprise モデル)、IPC シリーズ、PC/AT を使用する場合

- ランタイムは信頼のできるパソコンでのみ使用してください。
- プロジェクトファイルの転送、またはその他の管理者権限が必要な操作を実行する場合を除き、管理者権限をもつアカウントで **Windows** にログインしないでください。
- **Windows** のセキュリティー機能を使用してください (パスワードの設定、自動ログアウト機能の使用など)。
- プロジェクトの管理者アカウントに安全なパスワードとセキュリティーを設定してください。

4.4 情報の改ざんから保護する

8.1 作画時の修正済み制限事項

HMIIMG-22115	(画面編集ソフトウェア) 以前のバージョンで作成されたプロジェクトファイルを最新の画面編集ソフトウェアで開いた場合、プロジェクトファイルの読み込みエラーが表示される問題を改修しました。
HMIIMG-19120	(アラーム/ロギング) バックアップメモリー (SRAM) に保存されている各データの合計が最大値に近い場合、アラームおよびロギングが正しく動作しない問題を改修しました。

8.2 表示器使用時の修正済み制限事項

HMIIMG-21289	(トレンドグラフ) [トレンドグラフ]オブジェクトで[グラフの種類]プロパティが[ノーマル]の場合、グラフを表示する範囲の単位を変更すると、ロギングされていない時間に移動する問題を改修しました。
HMIIMG-23118	(ロギング) ロギングデータが無い状態でスクリプトの[ログデータをエクスポート]オペレーションを複数回実行した場合、ランタイムで画面の切り替えが遅くなる問題を改修しました。

HMIIMG-23851	(サイバーセキュリティ) 以下のセキュリティの脆弱性に対処するため、 Microsoft Edge WebView2 ランタイムエバグリーンインストーラーが最新バージョンに更新されました。 CVE-2025-2783

9 制限事項

この章では、画面編集ソフトウェア、ランタイムにおける制限事項を説明しています。

9.1 インストーラーの制限事項

HMIIMG-9134	(画面編集ソフトウェア) 画面編集ソフトウェアのインストール先に Unicode 文字を含むパスを指定するとインストールが失敗します。 Unicode 文字を含まないパスを指定してください。
HMIIMG-20159	(画面編集ソフトウェア) 画面編集ソフトウェアまたはランタイムの使用中に [アプリケーションを終了しない (再起動が必要になる場合があります)] を選択してアンインストールした場合、完全にアンインストールすることができません。アンインストールは画面編集ソフトウェアまたはランタイムを終了してから行ってください。
HMIIMG-20811	(画面編集ソフトウェア) Visual Studio の Visual C++ 再頒布可能パッケージが事前にインストールされていない場合、画面編集ソフトウェアのインストール中に再起動のダイアログボックスが表示されます。再起動後はインストールが再開されないため、再度画面編集ソフトウェアのインストーラーを実行してください。
HMIIMG-21285	(ランタイム) ランタイムのインストールまたはアンインストールで、パソコンを再起動せずにインストールとアンインストールを繰り返した場合、一時フォルダーに多くのファイルが作成され、ディスク容量を消費する場合があります。この場合は、一時フォルダー内のファイルを削除するか、インストールまたはアンインストール後にパソコンを再起動してください。
HMIIMG-23097	(画面編集ソフトウェア) Windows のフォルダーパスの最大文字数は 260 文字です。インストール先フォルダーのパスが 70 文字を超えるとインストールに失敗する場合があります。失敗した場合はインストール先フォルダーのパスを短くしてください。

9.2 作画時の制限事項

HMIIMG-14754	(画面編集ソフトウェア) 画面編集ソフトウェアで、スクリプトにエラーがあった場合、エラーウィンドウに表示されるエラーの数がブロックモードとテキストモードで異なる場合があります。

HMIIMG-3101	(コンテンツ表示器) コンテンツ表示器および参照先コンテンツの幅・高さの値を、他のプロパティやスクリプトから参照しても、値が正しく取得できない場合があります。
HMIIMG-337	(フォント) フォントの種類に含まれる、 Chinese_Simplified_GB2312_Gothic は将来のバージョンにて使用できなくなる予定です。 このフォントを使用した古いバージョンのプロジェクトファイルを本バージョンで開くと、 Chinese_Simplified_GB18030_Gothic に変換されます。
HMIIMG-10595	(スクリプト) スクリプト編集画面のテキストモードで検索と置換を使用する場合、特殊文字 (' \$ ' 、 ' ^ ' 、 ' * ' など) を含む検索が正しく動作しないことがあります。
HMIIMG-9909	(スクリプト) スクリプト編集画面がテキストモードの場合、[参照項目]ウィンドウからテキストモードのスクリプトを置換することはできません。スクリプト編集画面の検索と置換を使用してください。
HMIIMG-3391	(トリガー / オペレーション) スクリプト上で、動作対象外のオブジェクトをタッチトリガーに指定しても、画面編集ソフトウェア上でエラーになりません。 -アラーム表示器 -ハードウェア設定 -レシピデータ表示器 -画像表示器 -ウェブブラウザー -全てのレイアウトオブジェクト -画面 / コンテンツ -グループオブジェクト
HMIIMG-8160	(アラーム) スクリプトでアラームメッセージを変更できません。画面編集ソフトウェアでアラームメッセージを変更するスクリプトを作成するとエラーが発生します。

HMIIMG-3294	(転送) プロジェクトファイルを転送中に[ALT]キーを押すと、転送に失敗する場合があります。

HMIIMG-19269	(シンボルリンク) フォルダー名を含めた変数名に他の変数名と同じ名前が含まれているシンボルファイルはインポートできません。名前が重複しないように変更してください。

9.3 表示器使用時の制限事項

HMIIMG-1198	(ハードウェア設定画面) ハードウェア設定画面上の操作によりランタイムが再起動した時、外部ストレージの認識状態が更新されない場合があります。この場合は、表示器を再起動してください。
HMIIMG-3272	(ハードウェア設定画面) ハードウェア設定画面内の操作ログ画面でフィルター設定画面[Filter Simplified]からフィルターを実行した場合、項目が正しく表示されない場合があります。
HMIIMG-9202	(ハードウェア設定画面) ハードウェア設定画面では、ドライバーごとに最大 32 台の機器の Scan Off Control が表示されます。ハードウェア設定画面から Scan Off Control を変更できない場合は、機器のソースプロパティ '.ScanOffControl'を使用して Scan Off Control を変更してください。
HMIIMG-2768	(キーパッド) キーパッド表示中に高速でタッチを繰り返した場合、押下時の反転表示が表示されない場合があります。 これは表示だけの問題で、値の書き込みは正常に行われます。

HMIIMG-10937	(テキストボックス) テキストボックスオブジェクトで太字属性を使用すると、画面編集ソフトウェアと表示器で表示される文字の太さが異なる場合があります。
HMIIMG-3157	(アラーム表示器) アラーム表示器のフィルター設定画面[Filter Simplified]に表示できる項目は 146 個までです。 147 個以上の項目がある場合は、[Search]にテキストを入力して絞り込むか、フィルター詳細設定画面[Filter Detailed]を使用してください。
HMIIMG-3272	(アラーム表示器) アラーム表示器のフィルター設定画面[Filter Simplified]でフィルターを実行した場合、項目が正しく表示されない場合があります。
HMIIMG-7465	(数値表示器) 数値表示器の[現在値]に、コンバーターと一緒にソースプロパティを設定している場合、数値表示器の[フォーマット]および[小数点桁数]プロパティが設定可能にもかかわらず、設定内容が適用されません。これらのプロパティの代わりに、コンバーターのプロパティで設定された内容が適用されます。対象のコンバーターは以下になります。 - 単位 - スケール - 定義式 上記は正しい動作であり、将来のバージョンアップにより、数値表示器の[フォーマット]および[小数点桁数]プロパティは、上記の場合では表示が無効になります。
HMIIMG-9007	(数値表示器) [Arabic_Gothic]または[Hebrew_Gothic]フォントで接頭辞や接尾辞を設定すると、表示器上の数値表示器で文字の順序が間違って表示されます。
HMIIMG-9613	(文字列表示器) IME で日本語入力する文字列表示器で[テキストを*として表示]を有効にしないでください。文字を入力する際に、現在格納されている文字列が表示されます。[テキストを*として表示]プロパティを使用する場合は、入力を開始する前に文字列をクリアするようにシステムを設計してください。
-	(ウェブブラウザー) ウェブブラウザー部品で TIFF および MNG 画像ファイルが非対応となりました。
HMIIMG-439	(トリガー / オペレーション) タッチ中のオブジェクトが、他のオブジェクトのアニメーションや、可視の変化によって隠された場合、タッチトリガー (Click または Release)はそのタイミングでは発生しません。トリガーはタッチ中オブジェクトが隠されていないものと認識して動作します。
-	(トリガー / オペレーション) [ファイル管理]オペレーションを使用する場合、ファイルまたはフォルダー名の文字が英語でない場合は[ファイル管理]オペレーションで表示されるダイアログ上でファイルまたはフォルダー名が正しく表示されません。
HMIIMG-14432	(トリガー / オペレーション) [オペレーションの結果]オペレーションを使用する場合、指定したオペレーションが失敗したときに、正しい結果が得られない場合があります。

HMIIMG-3316	(ログイン)[ファイル管理]オペレーションの実行中は、ログの周期によってはデータがログされない場合があります。
-	(ネットワーク) 運転中、ローカルネットワーク上に存在する他の機器と重複する IP アドレスを設定しようとする場合や、表示器と重複する IP アドレスを持つ機器をローカルネットワークに接続した場合、IP アドレスの重複を検出できません。 ランタイム起動時のみ、ローカルネットワーク上に存在する機器の IP アドレスをチェックし、表示器と重複があればシステムエラーを発報します。表示器の IP アドレス変更後はランタイムが再起動されますので、再起動後にシステムエラーが発報されていないか確認してください。
HMIIMG-9614	(Web Viewer) プロジェクトの転送が失敗した場合、Web Viewer ライセンスは削除されます。同じライセンスキーコードを使用して、表示器で Web Viewer を再度追加してください。
HMIIMG-15921	(Web Viewer) 配管オブジェクトで、[影]を有効にし、完全に水平または垂直な形状で使用情况した場合、iOS および iPadOS 上の Web Viewer で正しく表示されない場合があります。
HMIIMG-438	(IPC シリーズ、PC/AT) ログイン、操作ログ、アラームのエクスポート先として、マルチバイト文字を含むフォルダー名またはファイル名を使用する場合、表示器の OS でシステムロケールを適切に設定する必要があります。
HMIIMG-438	(IPC シリーズ、PC/AT) 画像表示器の[保存先フォルダー]および画像のファイル名にマルチバイト文字を含む場合、表示器の OS でシステムロケールを適切に設定する必要があります。

-	(ウェブブラウザ) ウェブブラウザ部品では Web Viewer は使用できません。マニュアルの[機能ガイド]の Web Viewer 動作環境に記載されているウェブブラウザを使用してください。
HMIIMG-19216	(トリガー / オペレーション) [塗り込み]に[放射グラデーション]を設定したオブジェクトでは、スクリプトで[カラーストップ]の各プロパティの値を変更してもオブジェクトには反映されません。
HMIIMG-9768	(テキストボックス) オブジェクトの[文字列]タブで文字飾りを斜体に設定した場合、リッチテキストタグでテキストの背景を設定しても背景は斜体になりません。
HMIIMG-20881	(外部ストレージ(USB ストレージ)) USB メモリーを取り外し、再度挿入してからレシピ機能を使用すると、正しく動作しません。この場合は、レシピを再度読み出してください。
HMIIMG-1773	(画面 / コンテンツ) 画面編集ソフトウェアとランタイムアプリケーションの描画は完全に一致しない場合があります。プロジェクトを表示器に転送する前に、シミュレーションで画面を確認してください。
HMIIMG-22979	(トリガー / オペレーション) 1つのトリガー内で同じ外部変数を複数回変更しても、値はすぐには反映されません。値を複数回変更したい場合は、内部変数を使用するか、[値の変更]トリガーを使用した別のスクリプトを作成してください。
HMIIMG-23418	(コンパウンドオブジェクト) [STRING]のコンパウンドオブジェクトプロパティで[バリデーションルール]に[文字列の長さ]を選択した場合、設定値の単位は画面編集ソフトウェアが文字数、ランタイムがバイト数になります。マルチバイト文字は1文字に2バイト以上が必要なため、ランタイムで入力できるマルチバイト文字数は、画面編集ソフトウェアで設定した文字数より少なくなります。
